- Students from all the California State Universities are eligible to take the survey



• 1. "Undergraduate students (Freshman, junior, sophomore, senior) are more likely to report feeling ashamed to apply for CalFresh food compared to graduate students-(Graduate year 1 and 2)."



Results

Hypothesis was confirmed...

"1.There were more undergraduates that reported strongly disagree, than agree and somewhat agree with feeling ashamed to apply for CalFresh food. (

An unexpected finding was that <u>sophomores</u><u>undergraduate were</u>
<u>disagreeing at the same rate</u>
<u>as graduate level students in</u>
<u>regards to stigma</u>.
